**RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A TWO (2) LOT SECTION
AT THE BARNWELL COUNTY CEMETERY**

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2005, Barnwell County Council passed Ordinance No. 2005-204 establishing the sale of lots at the Barnwell County Cemetery, and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provides that Council, when necessary, will designate new areas for indigent burials and for the sale of two (2) lots when they are requested,

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that, in addition to any remaining two (2) plot availability, the section containing blocks 220 through 225 at the Barnwell County Cemetery be designated to allow for the sale of two (2) plots (\$250 per plot) with the block/lot assignment being at the discretion of the Barnwell County Administrator at the time of sale.

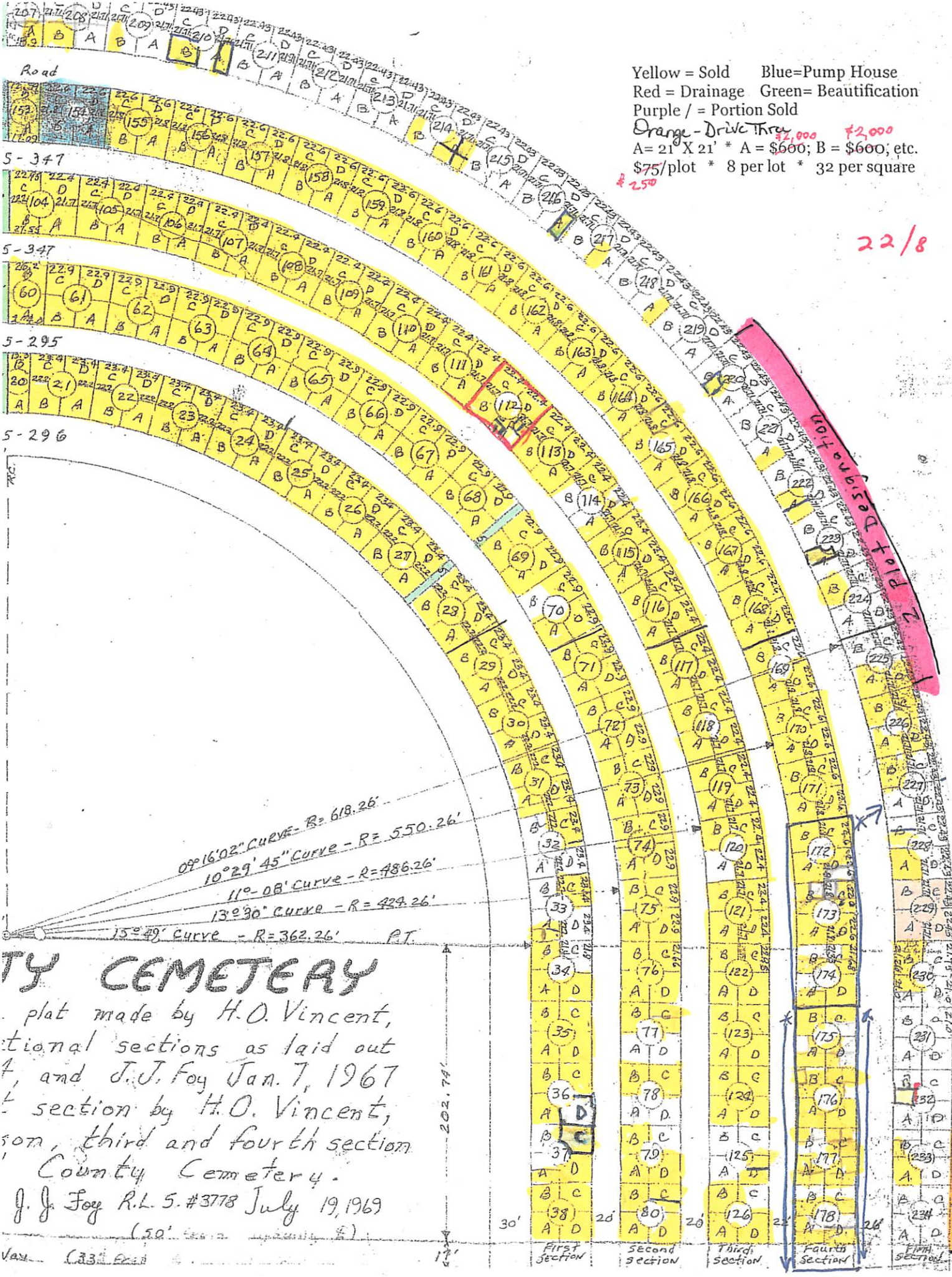

ORDINANCE NO. 2005-204

**An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1995-75
establishing sales of lots at the Barnwell County Cemetery.**

WHEREAS, Barnwell County Council believes it is in the best interest of all citizens of Barnwell County to adjust the price for the sale of lots at the Barnwell County Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, Barnwell County Council believes it is in the best interest of all citizens of Barnwell County to have an Ordinance governing conduct at the County Owned Cemetery;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED that Barnwell County, through its County Administrator, shall continue to sell lots at the Barnwell County Cemetery. The price of each burial lot shall be Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00). The County Administrator shall have the authority to collect all monies for cemetery lots and shall determine which lots are available for sale. A Certificate of Ownership for lots shall be signed by the Administrator or his designee with the Council's seal affixed thereto. Grave sites will be sold in sections of four (4) at a cost of \$1,000 (\$250.00 each). Sections will be designated for indigent burial and for the sale of two (2) lots when requested. When these sections are filled, County Council will designate new areas for indigent burials and for the sale of two (2) lot sections.

Guidelines for County Owned Cemetery


1. The Barnwell County Public Services Committee will oversee the cemetery.
2. The cemetery has been surveyed in plots that consist of approximately eight (8) graves which will be sold for \$2,000 per plot or \$250 per grave.
3. Graves must be cleaned off within two (2) weeks of a funeral.
4. Names and addresses of next of kin will be provided to the County Administrator at the time of purchase.
5. All bodies must be cremated or embalmed.

This Ordinance may be amended by Resolution and shall take effect upon third reading approval.


This Ordinance shall become effective upon its third reading. Adopted at the regular meeting of Barnwell County Council on May 3, 2005.


