AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

WHEREAS, Barnwell County has established a litter control ordinance, (Ordinance No. 2005-237-O), and

WHEREAS, South Carolina Code § 4-9-145 provides that counties may establish code enforcement officers for the security, welfare and convenience of the County; and

WHEREAS, Barnwell County has determined that it is in the best interest of the County for its Solid Waste Director to be a code enforcement officer without the power of arrest, in order to reduce the problem of litter at and around its landfill; and

WHEREAS, Barnwell County has adopted International Building Codes (Ordinance No. 2003-181-O) as promulgated from time to time by the South Carolina Building Codes Council; and

WHEREAS, S.C. Code § 6-8-10 et seq., provides that the Counties may designate their building inspectors as code enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, Barnwell County has determined that it is in the best interest of the County for its Building Codes Inspector to be a code enforcement officer without the power of arrest;

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that

The Barnwell County Solid Waste Director and the Barnwell County Building
 Inspector become code enforcement officers with the power to issue uniform
 citations and issue penalties for violations of the Barnwell County ordinances set

forth above, as amended from time to time, and

 That such code enforcement officers undergo such training as may be required by the State of South Carolina to be qualified as code enforcement officers.

This ordinance takes effect upon three readings and a public hearing.
